- 1. Students are required to go to the school website 'LTY Learn From Home' every school day, attend online lessons as scheduled and complete their assignments.
- 2. As teachers will take attendance, students should attend online lessons on time. For sick leave, if a student is sick and intends to be absent, please phone the school office before 9 a.m.
- 3. Teachers will use Microsoft Teams to conduct online lessons using a brand-new curriculum for this academic year. We expect students to pay full attention to the lessons.

- 4. Before the lesson, students need to go to the school website (LTY Learn From Home) and log in to their accounts, in order to attend the real-time lessons (for logon procedures, please read the Microsoft Teams Student Handbook). Account details will be sent to both students' and parents' emails.
- 5. When the real-time lesson starts, the host teacher will mute the student participants to prevent unwanted noise. When the teacher asks questions, he/she will unmute participants.
- 6. During the real-time lesson, students are required to turn the webcam on.
- 7. To ensure copyright protection and personal privacy, students are not allowed to record or do a screen capture without the teacher's permission.
- 8. After the online lesson, please complete and submit the assignments on Microsoft Teams.
- 9. The teacher will mark student assignments to monitor their learning progress.

Part B: Parent-teacher Communication

- Class teachers will keep parents informed about lesson arrangements and learning progress by phone, from time to time.

- 3. Students are required to submit six passport photos (wearing school uniform) (50 mm X 38 mm). (Girls have to tie up their long hair while boys' hair must not reach the collar). As we will not arrange any shops to provide photo-taking service this year, parents have to make their own arrangements.
- 4. Parents who would like to apply for The School Textbook Assistance or The Student Travel Subsidy may obtain application forms from District Offices under the Home Affairs Department.
