#### P.2-P.5 First Term Mid-Term Examination 2020/2021

- 1. The details of P.2-P.5 first term mid-term examination are as follows. The examination timetable and the exam coverage are attached.
- 2. Due to the coronavirus disease, cross-boundary students are not able to return to school for the examination. Therefore we exempt those students (P.2-P.5) from the exam. However, if they are able to return to Hong Kong, they will have the same exam arrangements as local students.
- 3. The arrangements for P.2-P.5 local students are as follows:
- ➤ Music, P.E., Chinese Speaking and English Speaking will be held from 2/11 to 11/11(Week 10-11).
- The Chinese and English writing papers include average marks from formative assessments. (Chinese writing paper: Chinese dictation and writing; English writing paper: English dictation and English Reader). There is no exam paper for Visual Arts as it is assessed through formative assessments.
- The mark allocation of each exam paper can be referred to the attached appendix.
- The school day starts at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 11:40 a.m. All the examinations will be held in the morning.
- According to the guidelines issued by the EDB, half-day schooling is implemented at this stage. Students should go straight home after school. We will not accept any request for your child to stay after school.
- There is no after-school care service and lunch period.
- Local school coach service will be provided as usual. But the school day ends at 11:40 a.m.
- No make-up examinations will be offered to students who are absent during the examination period except for sick leave with the medical certificate. Parents are required to submit a written request before the make-up exam which will be held between 18<sup>th</sup> November (Wednesday) and 19<sup>th</sup> November, 2020 (Thursday).
- 4. Parents should encourage students to work hard for the examination.
