Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Arrangements for the 1st Term Final Examination 2020-2021

1. Dates for the 1st term Final Examination

Parents were informed earlier that the 1st term Final Examination was scheduled to be held from 14th January, 2021 to 19th January, 2021. If classes resume, the examination will be held as scheduled. However if the Education Bureau has not announced class resumption, the examination **will be postponed**. Details will be announced through e-School later.

2. The arrangements for P.6 second score submission

The 2nd term Mid-term Examination held between 23rd March, 2021 and 26th March, 2021 is the second score submission. If the 1st term Final Examination is postponed to late February 2021, or that the pandemic continues to affect the timetable for the 2nd term mid-term examination, the school will use the academic result from the 1st term Final Examination for the second score submission. Details are as follows:

We hope all P.6 students will study hard for the examination. The arrangements for the 2nd term mid-term examination will be announced later.

3. Arrangements for cross-boundary students

We plan to hire an examination venue in **Shenzhen** so that cross-boundary students can also take an examination. Details will be announced as soon as possible once the examination venue is confirmed.

4. Cancellation of the assessments of the following subjects

Due to the pandemic, we have decided to cancel the assessments of the following subjects:

- 1) P.1-P.6 Computer
- 2) P.1-P.6 Music (singing)

5. Adjustments of the average marks from formative assessments (1st term Final Examination)

Chinese Language	P.1-P.2: Average marks from dictation will not be included in the mark calculation for the final examination P.3-P.6: Average marks from Chinese dictation and writing will not be included in the final examination
English Language	P.1-P.6: Average marks from English dictation and reader will not be included in the final examination
Visual Arts	P.1-P.6: Scores from formative assessments will not be included in the final examination

6. Others

1. Since assessments of some of the subjects are cancelled, mark calculation for the first term will be affected. Details will be announced later.
2. No make-up examinations will be offered to local students who are absent during the examination period except for sick leave with the medical certificate or special reasons. Parents are required to call the General Office and submit a medical certificate to the class teacher. Dates for the make-up exam will be announced later. There is no make-up exam for cross-boundary students due to the venue issue.
3. If a local student, due to a personal reason, has to return to mainland and is therefore absent from the examination, he /she **will not** be exempt from the examination. No make-up exam will be provided in this case. Determination of a student's status as either local or cross-border will depend on the child's status prior to the pandemic.

The pandemic is not under control yet. We encourage all parents and students to fight the virus together in such a difficult time.
