Arrangements of P.5- P.6 Face-to-face Classes

As the situation of COVID-19 remains severe, the Education Bureau announced that all schools would further suspend face-to-face classes and school activities after their scheduled Christmas holidays until January 10, 2021. Schools can arrange students of any individual level to return to schools in the morning to attend half-day face-to-face classes or take examinations.

Considering the fact that P.1-P.4 students are relatively young, and that P.5-P.6 students have to prepare for the examination for score submission, we have decided to arrange for P.5 and P.6 students to return to school to attend half-day face-to-face classes and take examinations in two phases. Details are as follows:
