Chinese New Year Holiday and Arrangements for Face-to-face Classes

The Education Bureau announced on 3rd February, 2021 that schools will be allowed to arrange for students to return to school after the Chinese New Year holiday (with the number of students capped at one-third of the total number of students). Details are as follows:

- 1. The Chinese New Year holiday will begin from 10th February, 2021 (Wednesday) to 20th February, 2021 (Saturday). The holiday lasts for 11 days.
- 2. The General Office will maintain the normal opening hours during the school holidays (except public holidays).

- P.1-P.2 students will return to school from 1/3 to 5/3 and attend online lessons on the other days.
- P.5-P.6 students will return to school from 8/3 to 19/3 and attend online lessons on the other days.
- · Arrangements for cross-boundary students: There will be a live broadcast via Microsoft Teams when local students have face-to-face classes.
- Students must wear winter school uniforms and surgical masks when they return to school.
- The face-to-face classes start from 8:30 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. Online classes start from 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.

- There will be no school bus service. Students may choose parent pick-up or follow the designated routes.
- The arrangements mentioned above are made after the announcement from the Education Bureau (3rd February, 2021). If there are any new arrangements from EDB, parents will be informed by email and e-School.
