### Parent Education Workshop

The Early Identification and Intervention Programme for Primary One students with learning difficulties aims at helping schools to identify early primary one students at risk of learning difficulties, so as to provide timely support where necessary. Our teachers completed the Observation Checklist for Teachers (OCT) for students suspected to be at risk of learning difficulties in January and February. According to the criteria provided by the OCT, your child has been identified with the following learning difficulties.

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The above result shows the current status of your child. Generally, learning support programmes, adjustment in classroom teaching and collaboration with parents can help students make satisfactory progress.

Through the school-based educational psychology service, parents can learn some effective learning skills such as paired-reading strategies, daily dictation activities and student learning plans. We hope that students' learning motivation will be enhanced and parents will learn how to deal with children with learning difficulties.
