**The 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Final Examination 2020-2021 (for local students)**

**(1) Examination Period**

The 2<sup>nd</sup> term final examinations will be held from 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 to 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2021. Please refer to **Appendix 1 and 2** for the examination timetable and coverage. The arrival time during the examination period is 8:30 a.m. The school day ends at 11:40 a.m.

Chinese and English speaking examination, singing test (P.1 - P.6), music theory (P.1 - P.4), PE and P.5 Visual Arts practice test will be conducted during the examination week (from 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2021 to 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2021).

**(2) Music Examination**

We have uploaded the educational videos for the music examination. Students should watch the videos from LTY Learn From Home and complete the online exercise before the examination. Please refer to **Appendix 2** for the video links.

**(3) Computer Examination.**

The examination will be cancelled. This will be graded as 'exempt' on the transcript.

**(4) Mark Adjustment**

The mark calculation for this exam **will not include** the average marks from Chinese dictation, Chinese writing, English dictation, English Reader or Visual Arts.

**(5) Others**

1. Dismissal arrangements: we will continue to provide a local school bus service during the examination period. Students may use our school bus service, follow the designated routes, or choose parent pick-up.
2. Due to the pandemic, students should go straight home after the examination. We will not accept any requests for your child to stay after school.
3. No make-up examination will be offered to students who are absent from the examinations except for sick leave with a medical certificate or for special reasons. Parents must call us and submit a medical certificate to your child's class teacher. The make-up examination will be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2021.

**(6) Arrangements for 1<sup>st</sup> Score Submission (P.5 Visual Arts)**

This examination is the 1<sup>st</sup> P.5 score submission. The marks from the Visual Arts test will be submitted to EDB. As cross-boundary students are not able to return to school, there will be special arrangements to ensure fairness and that no student is disadvantaged. Details are as follows:

**【Transcript】 Subjects and Weighting for Exam Composition (2020-2021)**

1. Mark calculation will be conducted twice in the academic year (first and second term respectively). The final result consists of the scores from the mid-term exam (40%) and the final exam (60%). Students' rank order of each subject will be shown in the final result.

**The final result = scores from the mid-term exam×40% + scores from the final exam×60%  
(mark calculation will be conducted separately.)**

2. Each subject has their own mark calculation.

**Chinese Language**

**Marks = Reading×40% + Writing×40% + Listening×10% + Speaking×10% .**

- ◆ For Computer Studies, assessments are cancelled. This will be graded as ‘exempt’ on the transcript.

### Music

**P.1-P.4** The final marks consist of two components (singing and music theory). Only the final marks are shown in the report. Full marks are 100.

**P.5-P.6** The final marks consist of two components (singing and music theory). The scores of these two components are shown in the report. Full marks are 100.

$$\text{Final marks} = \text{Singing test} \times 60\% + \text{Music theory} \times 40\%$$

3. Average mark calculation is applied for the ranking and final result. The mark calculation and weighting ratios are as follows:

$$\text{Average marks} = \text{Chinese Language} \times \frac{9}{35} + \text{English Language} \times \frac{9}{35} + \text{Mathematics} \times \frac{9}{35} + \text{General Studies} \times \frac{6}{35} + \text{Music} \times \frac{2}{35}$$

For example : If a P.1-4 or P.6 student gets 78 marks in Chinese Language, 89 marks in English Language, 82 marks in Mathematics, 85 marks in General Studies and 85 marks in Music. His final average marks are:

$$78 \times \frac{9}{35} + 89 \times \frac{9}{35} + 82 \times \frac{9}{35} + 85 \times \frac{6}{35} + 85 \times \frac{2}{35} = 83.46 \quad (\text{correct to 2 decimal places})$$
