## **Resumption of Face-to-Face Classes (Primary 2 & 4)**

Students who received a negative test result for COVID-19 will begin to have face-to-face classes again on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 (Monday). Details are as follows:

- 1. All primary 2 & 4 teachers have undergone compulsory testing and received negative test results.
- 2. Parents are required to upload the test result via Microsoft Teams (chat room-class teacher) before 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 (Saturday).
- 3. Under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) Regulation (Cap. 599J), the government can exercise the power and publish in the Gazette a compulsory testing notice. Any person who fails to comply with the testing notices commits an offence and may be fined a fixed penalty of \$5,000. The person would also be issued with a compulsory testing order requiring him or her to undergo testing within a specified time frame. Failure to comply with the order is an offence and the offender would be liable to a fine at level 4 (\$25,000) and imprisonment for six months.
- 4. For those who are not able to upload a test result before  $5^{th}$  June, 2021 (Saturday), your class teachers will contact you by phone individually.
- 5. Those who have not received the test result before 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 (Monday) will not be allowed to return to school for face-to-face classes.
- 6. The school day starts from 8:30 a.m. to 12: 45 p.m. (for students who receive negative test results)
- 7. Students must wear proper summer school uniform and masks when they return to school.
- 8. P.1, P.3, P.5 and P.6 classes remain <u>unchanged</u>. Please come to school for <u>face-to-face classes as scheduled</u>.
