## District-based Afterschool Study and Support Plan

The Education Bureau has implemented the district-based afterschool study and support plan with the aim to provide afterschool support for underprivileged students, increase their participation in afterschool activities, and broaden their afterschool learning experience. The target will be students under the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) Scheme, Tertiary Student Finance Scheme (TSFS), and $25 \%$ of the school's discretion quota. Student fees will be free of charge. The school will cooperate with Tuen Mun Christian Grace Chapel in organizing the district-based plan, details of activities are as follows:
