Regarding the "Arrangements for 2021-2022 First Semester Midterm Exams" (Applicable to Local Students)

(1) Exam dates

The midterm exams for the first semester of this year will be held from 4th November to 9th November, 2021. For the timetable and exam coverage, please refer to <u>Annex 1 and 2</u>. During the exam period, the school will start at 8:30 a.m. and end at 11:20 a.m. Chinese Speaking, English Speaking, Music Singing (P1-6), Music Theory (P1-4), and Physical Education exams will be held from 21st October to 3rd November during lesson times.

(3) Other Things of Note:

- 1. The school will arrange coach services, return teams and parents pickup during the exam period;
- 2. To reduce risk of infection, all students should return home as soon as possible upon dismissal, <u>applications for staying at school would not be accepted;</u>
- 3. Students are not allowed to be absent without reason. If students would like to apply for makeup exams due to sickness or special reasons, parents must call and notify the school on the day of absence and hand in the doctor's certificate and documents to the class teacher on the next day. The school will notify parents the date and time of the makeup exam. All makeup exams must be finished before 11th November;
- 4. If students are unable to attend makeup exams, the average score of the makeup exam would not be counted, the ranking of the student would also not be shown on the report card;
- 5. If classes are suspended due to "Tropical Cyclones and Heavy Persistent Rain and Rainstorms", the exam dates will be postponed;
- 6. After exams, class teachers will check exam papers with students during lessons, for students to understand their learning progress. The school will distribute Chinese Reading, Chinese Writing, English Reading, Mathematics, General Knowledge, and Music exam papers for parents to review and understand their children's learning progress and effectiveness.
- 7. Please refer to <u>Annex 3</u> for the calculation method of the report card, please keep it until the end of the school year. Exams are coming, all students please study hard. If parents have any questions about the exam arrangements, please call 2404 5333 for inquires.

Annex 3

[Academic Report Card] Description of Weightings of Subjects and Sub-papers (2021-2022)

1. The score of the whole semester will be calculated once every semester of the school year. "Semester grades" are calculated by the "Mid-term Examination" and "Semester Examination", of which the "Mid-term Examination" accounts for 40%, the "Semester Examination" accounts for 60%, and the "Semester total scores" of each subject are ranked.

Total Semester Score = Midterm Examination Results×40% + Semester Examination Results×60% (First and Second Semesters calculated independently)

2. The total score and average score in the report card are calculated by subject group:

Chinese Language Score = Reading×40% + Writing×40% + Listening×10% + Speaking×10%

- ◆ Primary 5 to 6: consists of two parts: "Singing" (60%) and "Musical Theory" (40%). The report card will show only two score, the total score is 100 marks.

Visual Arts Subject

- Primary 1 and 2 will take the average score, the report card will only show one score, the total score is 100 marks.
- Primary 3 to 4 will be calculated by exempt subjects.
