**District-based Afterschool Learning and Support Programme**

The District-based After-School Learning and Support Scheme is implemented by the Education Bureau to provide after-school support to underprivileged students, increase their opportunities to participate in after-school activities, and broaden students' extra-curricular learning experience. The target of this program are those receiving **Comprehensive Social Security Assistance, full subsidy of the Student Financial Assistance Scheme** and the 25% discretionary quota of the school. **The registration fee for students is free of charge.** Our school along with the Tuen Mun Grace Chapel will co-organize the district-based programme.
