Registration of Second Term of Saturday Extra-curricular Activities

To enable students to achieve whole-person development, the school will begin appropriate amounts of extra-curricular activities on Saturday morning. The registration matters are as follows:

1. The musical instrument classes and scouts in the first term are year-round activities and have undergone recruitment in the first semester. New registrations will not be accepted.
2. If students who participated in activities in the first term continue to participate in the activity, admission priority will be given to ensure the continuity of their learning. Newly registered students will only be considered if there are still vacancies in the activity. Successful applicants will receive an admission notice on or before 11th February (Friday), which will be posted on P.72 of the handbook. The notification will display the activity name, activity fee and other information. Students who are not admitted will not be notified.
3. The school will deduct the activity fee from the student's smart card account. If parents notice insufficient funds in the account, they can go to the school office to add value with cash. Once the fee is paid, there will be no refunds if you apply to withdraw from the event due to personal reasons.
4. For activities please refer to the "Second Term Saturday Extracurricular Activities List" on the following page. The fees shown are the fees that parents need to pay after deducting the Life-wide Learning Grant. Unless otherwise stated, the fee includes the tutor fee and materials fee.
5. The first class of the Second Term Saturday extracurricular activities will be held on 19th February, 2022. The detailed dates will be displayed in the admission notice.

Remarks:

1. Bicycle beginners class is at the advanced stage of the balance bike beginners class in the first term. It will teach students the skills and safety matters of riding a two-wheeled bicycle.
2. Table Tennis (Junior Primary) and Table Tennis (Senior Primary) are new events in the second term, mainly focusing on teaching basic skills of table tennis.
