Arrangements for Suspension of Face-to-face Classes

In view of the unstable situation of the COVID-19 epidemic, the Education Bureau has announced the suspension of face-to-face classes until the end of the Chinese New Year Holiday. Details of arrangements are as follows:

1. 13th January (Thursday) Arrangements for Face-to-face Classes

13th January (Thursday) will be the last day of face-to-face classes, all students will be dismissed at 11:20 a.m. (School bus and return teams as usual)

3. Cancellation of First Term School Term Exams

- The First Term School Term Exams will be cancelled, the school has distributed the exam brown envelopes to students on 12th January (Wednesday), parents please arrange for students to finish the exam papers at home; teachers will explain exam papers to students through online classes on 14th January (Friday) to 18th January (Tuesday)

4. Arrangements for Online Classes

- From 14th January (Friday) to 28th January (Friday) students are required to login to "LTY Learn From Home" on the school's website every Monday to Friday to have online classes through the Microsoft Teams platform;
- The time for Online Classes is from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (following the usual lesson timetable);
- Cross-border students take online lessons according to their original classes.

5. Handling of Homework

- Teachers will write the homework content on the homework channel on TEAMS, parents can also check the homework content from "Daily Homework" on the school website;
- Teachers will distribute the answers for Chinese, English, Math and LS Class-based exercises and Chinese self-learning handbook through TEAMS for students to check the answers themselves;
- Other assignments and school-based unit work will be due later in face-to-face classes.

6. Chinese New Year Holiday

- The Chinese New Year Holiday will start from 31st January (Monday) to 10th February (Thursday), 11th February (Friday) lessons will resume (parents please pay close attention to e School and the latest announcements on the school's website)
- Primary 1 to 4 students need to finish Chinese and English Holiday Book Report, Primary 5 to 6 students need to finish HKAT supplementary exercises, and hand over to subject teachers after the New Year Holiday for review.
