Drama Wonderland Introduction:

Our troupe is a professional theatre educational group with rich experience in stage performances. Members of the group have produced and performed in over 1500 school touring theatres and have served as drama instructors in various secondary and primary schools. With the cooperation of various talents, our group has mastered musical touring, theatre touring, administration, education, art, as well as the ability to induce students' thinking and communication skills. Through professional performances and passion for theatre, our group hopes to contribute to the education sector.

Theatre Outline of "Doctor on the Line":

Through lively and interesting interactive drama performance, "Doctor on the Line" invites primary school students to answer questions in Putonghua, thus enhancing their interest and initiative in learning Putonghua. The play will let students know to tell their parents immediately when they feel sick through real life situations. When they need to see a doctor, they need not to be nervous and scared. They need only to describe clearly how they are unwell, and the doctor will be able to prescribe the right medicine to restore their health. The story also brings out the positive message of solving problems together as a family.

Theatre Outline:

The couple Chan Xiao and Chan Xiao, along with their son Chan Xiao, go on a self-driving trip to the mainland. When at a remote location, son Chen Xiao suddenly has a stomachache. Father Chen Xiao then drives to the hospital while Mother Chen Xiao calls the hospital to make an early appointment for their son's treatment. The three of them do not speak Putonghua well and have great difficulty in describing Chen Xiao's symptoms, thus causing many misunderstandings. Fortunately, with the help of different characters, they were not only able to help the doctor understand Chen Xiao's condition at the end, but also learn Putonghua commonly used in medical treatments.
