### “Extended Suspension of Face-to-face Classes and On-campus Activities”

Since the epidemic situation is still severe, the Education Bureau has announced the suspension of face-to-face classes and on-campus activities until 21<sup>st</sup> February. Details of arrangements are as follows:

#### 1. Chinese New Year Holidays

During the Chinese New Year Holidays from 31<sup>st</sup> January (Monday) to 10<sup>th</sup> February (Thursday), P.1 to P.4 students are required to complete Chinese and English holiday reading reports, P.5 and P.6 students are required to finish the HKAT Supplementary Exercise and return to school for submission by parents in groups on 16<sup>th</sup> February or 17<sup>th</sup> February.

#### 2. Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> February to Monday, 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2022 Online Class Arrangements

- From Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> February to Monday, 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2022 students are required to login to the school website “LTY Learn From Home” every day from Monday to Friday to attend online classes through the Microsoft Teams platform;
- Online classes will be from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (following the usual class schedule);
- Cross-border students will attend online classes according to their original classes.

#### 3. The school will arrange for parents to return to school in groups to submit holiday homework and pick up books and school-based assignments for the second semester:
