“Special Holiday Arrangements”

In view of the current extreme situation of the fifth wave coronavirus disease in Hong Kong, the number of confirmed cases continues to break new records, the Education Bureau announced that holidays originally scheduled for July and August will be advanced to March and April, each arrangements are as follows:

1. Holiday Adjustments

- The special holiday will be from 7th March (Monday) to 24th April (Sunday);
- Afternoon homework tutorial classes will be suspended during the special holiday;
- To reduce risk of infection, parents should arrange for children to stay at home;
- The school will resume face-to-face classes on 25th April (Monday) when the epidemic has subsided and under feasible situations;
- The last school day of this school year will be 12th August (Friday).

2. Special Holiday Homework

To make good use of the holiday and improve students' reading skills, students are required to complete the following homework during the special holiday:

3. Exam Arrangements

- Second Semester Midterm Exam: the second semester midterm exams from 22nd to 25th March will be **cancelled**, until the resume of face-to-face classes, subject teachers will explain the exam papers for students;
- Second Semester School Term Exam:

Academic Exams:	29 th June (Wednesday) to 6 th July (Wednesday)
Exam Week:	7 th July (Thursday) to 12 th July (Wednesday)

4. Arrangements for Secondary School Places Allocation

The schedule of the secondary school places allocation will be postponed accordingly due to the holiday adjustment, details are as follows:

28 th (Thursday) and 29 th July (Friday)	Students register to the assigned secondary school

5. Arrangements for Vaccine Pass

The “Vaccine Pass” has been implemented on 24th February, 2022 (Thursday). Other than exempted individuals, all visitors are required to show records of at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccination to enter the school.

Parents should monitor their children's physical and mental health and practice disease prevention measures. Students should avoid going outside, especially towards crowded or places with poor air circulation, and maintain a healthy diet, exercise regularly and have enough rest to strengthen their immune systems.
