A sample parental consent form can be downloaded from the Vaccination Programme thematic website: www.covidvaccine.gov.hk/pdf/Consent_Form_for_COVID19_Vaccination_CHI.pdf</p> <p>(2) Students must be accompanied by their parents/guardians in person to receive vaccination.</p> <p>(3) Vaccine recipients must bring their original identification documents to receive vaccination.
