Start of Second Term Saturday Extracurricular Activities

Following the Health Protection Measures for Schools announced by the Education Bureau on 19th May, students are required to take their temperature and do the rapid antigen test and obtain a negative test result before they are allowed to return to school to participate in the extracurricular activities on Saturday mornings. In view of this, the school immediately contacted instructors of the activities and compiled a group list according to students' previous activity preferences, to start the Saturday extracurricular activities as soon as possible. Teachers have posted the enrollment notice on page 72 of the student handbook. That notice displayed student's name and information of enrollment. Most activities will start on Saturday, 28th May. Parents please check and remind your children to attend on time.

The continuous epidemic has impacted to all industries and may have brought financial pressure upon different families. To relieve parents' financial pressure, and support students in participating in extracurricular activities to have a healthy physical and mental development, the school has decided to fully subsidize the instructor fees of the activities of enrolled students.

Please be reminded that students returning to school on Saturday to participate in activities must show their temperature of that day and the negative result of the rapid antigen test to the teacher along with the parent's signature confirmation in order to enter the school (requirements same as returning to school for classes on Monday to Friday). As the test declaration and temperature record table posted on page 68 of the student handbook before did not include 28th May, parents please add the related information below the record table, the format reference can be found on the annex. The test declaration and temperature record table soon to be distributed in June will include the dates of Saturdays, parents can then fill in the related information directly in the record table.
