Multiple Cases of Upper Respiratory Tract Infections in 1A

Multiple cases of upper respiratory tract infections (coughing and runny nose) were found in Class 1A on Friday, 17th June, 2022. The school has reported to the Centre for Health Protection and immediately made the following arrangements:

1. Immediately arrange new classrooms for students of the class;
2. Immediately disinfect classroom 1A;
3. Open windows and doors during lessons for better ventilation indoors.

According to the instructions of the Centre for Health Protection, class suspension is not necessary at this stage. Parents are advised to keep an eye on their student's physical condition, pay attention to personal hygiene and complete the rapid antigen test before class everyday to ensure that a "negative" test report is obtained and seek medical attention as soon as possible if they are feel unwell. Our school will continue to strengthen the cleaning and disinfection of the school to ensure a hygienic and healthy environment for students.
