The student diagnosed will follow the guidelines to report to the Department of Health and will not return to school until he/she has received two consecutive negative rapid antigen test results on the sixth and seventh days after the confirmed diagnosis.

According to the guielines of the Education Bureau, all teachers and students are required to take the rapid antigen test every day before coming to school, the tests should be conducted every morning and only if they have the negative results can they return to school. Parents please continue to assist your child in completing the rapid antigen test and recording their temperature, and fill in and sign the "Test Declaration and Temperature Record Table" for teachers to check at school.
