Arrangements for “Registration for the first Saturday Extra Curricular Activities”

To enable students to develop whole-person development, the school will start a moderate amount of Extra Curricular Activities on Saturday mornings. Registration details are as follows:

1. Students can fill in at least 1 choice and at most 3 choices. If the number of applicants exceeds the limit, students who have not been admitted to the activity will be given priority. If there is still spaces, they will be admitted by lottery. Admitted students will receive an admission notice on or before Friday, 30th September, 2022 which will be posted on P.72 "Notice of Extra Curricular Activities" in the handbook. The admission notice will show the activity name, fees, class date, time and venue, please keep it safe. Students who are not admitted will not be notified otherwise.
2. After receiving the admission notice, students need to pay the activity fee with their smart card account to confirm their participation in the activity. If the account balance is insufficient, parents can go to the school office to increase funds by cash. Once the fee is paid, no refunds will be made upon withdrawal from the activity due to personal reasons.
3. For activities please refer to the "First Saturday Extracurricular Activities List" on the back page. The fees shown on the list are the amount that parents need to pay after the Life-wide Learning Grant is deducted. Unless otherwise stated, the fees already include tutor fees and material fees.
4. The first session of class of the first extracurricular activities on Saturday will be on 8th October, 2022 and the detailed dates will be shown in the admission notice.

Remarks: • If you are interested in participating in violin or Hawaiian ukulele activities, please reply in the reply slip whether you need to order musical instruments from the contractor.
• If you are unable to attend the selected event, please call back to school and tell the name of your child, reason for leave, and the participated activity.

Remarks: As continuous training is needed to ensure effective learning, the violin, Guzheng and Hawaiian Ukulele will be charged for 20 sessions throughout the year.
