On-school Counselling Service and Individual Parent Meeting

The school makes use of a learning support grant to hire clinical psychologist to provide on-site counselling services to assist students with special educational needs and with weak academic performance. A counselling psychologist, Ms. Gigi Pang, from “Edge Development Centre” will be responsible for providing individual or group counselling services.

In terms of the service scope, students will be assessed through individual interviews and conduct individual or group practices in class with a pull-out teaching approach. The teaching content will be designed to fit the needs of students, and training will be carried out according to student’s social, emotional, attentiveness and other aspects, so as to improve emotional self-regulation skills and meanwhile enhance social skills, attentiveness, memory and information processing speed which effectively help students better adapt to campus life.
