#### 2. Dates:

	Phase 2:	13 <sup>th</sup> November, 2023 to 12 <sup>th</sup> January, 2024
<b>Second Semester:</b>	Phase 3:	26 <sup>th</sup> February, 2024 to 5 <sup>th</sup> April, 2024
	Phase 4:	22 <sup>nd</sup> April, 2024 to 31 <sup>st</sup> May, 2024

#### 3. Activities and Rewards:

- Each phase will have an activity booklet, and students are required to complete the designated tasks for each phase. After completion, they will receive stamps or parental signatures as verification.
- Students can accumulate stamps or signatures to exchange for opportunities to use the capsule vending machine and receive corresponding rewards
- The top 50 students with the most stamps at the end of each semester will receive additional ultimate prizes.

#### 4. Task and Reward Criteria:

(A) Theme Tasks: Assigned by the homeroom teacher or designated teacher, with a maximum of one task per day.
