“Regarding the “Historical, Cultural, and Technological Exploration Trip to Guangzhou and Zhuhai”

To enhance students' understanding and sense of belonging to our country, the school plans to arrange a "Historical, Cultural, and Technological Exploration Trip" for Grade 5-6 students as part of the " Exploration into the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Cities " programme organized by the Education Bureau. Details are as follows:

Date	8 th to 9 th December, 2023 (2 days and 1 nights)
Name of Itinerary	Historical, Cultural, and Technological Exploration Trip to Guangzhou and Zhuhai (High-speed rail and high-speed ferry)
Location	Guangzhou and Zhuhai
Target Audience	All students from Primary 5 to 6 (excluding students selected for the Nanjing and Shanghai Historical and Cultural Study Tour)
Required Documents	Students must hold valid travel documents, including Child Identity Cards (if the card does not have a photo, students must have a HKSAR Re-entry Permit or passport). The school will notify participating students to submit photocopies of these travel documents to their class teachers.
Cost	The participation fee is HKD 1,207 per student. After deducting subsidies from the Education Bureau and Life-wide Learning Grant, each student will need to pay HKD 150. This fee covers the cost of visits, meals, accommodation, transportation, and basic group comprehensive travel insurance. The fee will be deducted from students' smart card accounts.
Activities Content	1. Learn about the history, culture and conservation of cultural relics in Panyu, Guangzhou, including Baomo Garden and Shawan Ancient Town. 2. Visit Aifeike Aviation Popularization of Science Education Base and Innovation Technology Enterprises to learn about China's technological development.
Organizer	Hong Kong Youth Education Exchange Centre
Remarks	The above activities are considered as a regular learning activity and are recommended for students to participate. If student is unable to attend, parents are required to submit a written application. Students should attend school as usual on 8 th December, 2023."
