	150. This fee covers the cost of visits, meals, accommodation, transportation, and
	basic group comprehensive travel insurance. The fee will be deducted from students'
	smart card accounts.

	Guangzhou, including Baomo Garden and Shawan Ancient Town.
	2. Visit Aifeike Aviation Popularization of Science Education Base and Innovation
