<b>Time:</b>	9:00 a.m. (Departure at 9:10 a.m. punctually, latecomers will not be entertained)
<b>Organizer :</b>	Great Travel (License: 352932)
<b>Fee:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HKD 180 per person (same rate for adults and children) (after deducting the subsidy from the Parent-Teacher Association)</li> <li>• The fee includes transportation, lunch, tour guide service fee, and HKD 100,000 travel insurance coverage.</li> </ul>
<b>Itinerary :</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 9:00 a.m.: Roll call at the school and departure (Departure at 9:10 a.m. sharp, no waiting for latecomers)</li> <li>• Travel by coach to Tong Fuk Beach on Lantau Island (one of the popular photo spots)</li> <li>• Visit Shui Hau on Lantau Island (search for horseshoe crabs and sand dollars; if weather permits, clam digging is possible)</li> <li>• Lunch at Venice Restaurant in Tai O (authentic fishing village-style meal)</li> <li>• Free time to explore the water village of Tai O (visit the Tin Hau Temple on Kau Tsuen Street, Stone Dragon Pavilion - the former Japanese military headquarters during the occupation period, stilt houses, dried seafood drying yards, and seafood street)</li> <li>• Return to the school by coach and disperse</li> </ul> <p>**The itinerary may be subject to changes due to weather conditions.</p>
<b>Return Time:</b>	Dismiss at the school gate around 4:30 p.m.
<b>Remarks:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The above activity is open to members of the school's Parent-Teacher Association, with a maximum of 5 participants per family.</li> <li>2. All students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian aged 18 or above.</li> <li>3. Participants should bring their own drinks, vomit bags, rain gear, and other personal items.</li> <li>4. Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety of their accompanying family members and themselves throughout the trip.</li> <li>5. Registration: Registration deadline is Friday, 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2024. There are 174 spots available on a first-come, first-served basis (based on payment received). Interested participants (if there are multiple children attending the school, the eldest child should be considered for registration) should submit the completed registration form along with the registration fee to the school office to secure a spot. Once registered (including absence on the day of the trip), refunds will not be provided.</li> </ol>
