Then they have to take photos of their work and upload them to Microsoft Teams Learning Platform. Please submit the hard copies of your work to Miss Ng Mei Ting or Mr. Chung after the course is completed.
4. Each work will be individually assessed by tutors. Good work may be published.
5. Students will receive login details by email.
